

Guide to posting web links to documents

- 1) If you don't have an account on our Linux systems, get one. For the rest of this document I will assume your user name is `USERNAME`
- 2) Place the document you wish to share somewhere in the `public_html` folder in your home directory (i.e. `/home/USERNAME/public_html/sample_file.txt`).
- 3) Form the web address. If you wish to share a document that has the file path `/home/USERNAME/public_html/TMP/folder1/sample_file.txt` the link will be `http://vonkarman.mae.ufl.edu/~USERNAME/TMP/folder1/sample_file.txt`
- 4) Test your link. If it doesn't work, here are a few things to note:
 - The web addresses are case sensitive
 - The address should not include the `public_html` folder as part of the path
 - The permissions on the file must be set to allow read access to others
 - Directories are not listable, you must send links to a specific file. If you wish to send an entire directory then make a `.zip` file and send that.
